- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow the Office of the Secretary of State to refuse to file
- 2 certain documents.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 The Office of the Secretary of State may refuse to file any document for any business entity
- 6 whether domestic or foreign, for profit or nonprofit, as provided in title 47, title 48, chapter 37-
- 7 6, or chapter 37-11 if the document contains any letter combination that carries connotations
- 8 offensive to good taste and decency, or consists of immoral, deceptive, or scandalous material.
