HOUSE BILL NO. 1124

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF TANNING DEVICES BY MINORS.

A prison or jail impact statement has been requested on HB1124 due to a penalty for allowing minors to use tanning beds.

The penalty in this Act is a Class 2 misdemeanor. Its purpose is to enforce compliance with the provisions to which it adheres. This offense could be prosecuted. However, if prosecuted, it will not likely result in a prison or jail sentence. Hence, the impact on prison or jail populations is negligible.
