1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding Indian education.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 13-1-48 be amended to read as follows:

4 13-1-48. ~~All teachers~~ Any teacher new to the profession, from out-of-state, or certified after

5 1993 shall complete ~~a three-hour~~ a three-credit-hour course in South Dakota Indian studies. The

6 course shall include components specific to:

7 (1) Language and cultural awareness;

8 (2) History;

9 (3) Educational theory and background of the traditional tribal education; and

10 (4) Implementation and strategies of Indian learning styles, curriculum development and

11 authentic assessment.
