- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 13-1-48 be amended to read as follows:
- 4 13-1-48. All teachers Any teacher new to the profession, from out-of-state, or certified after
- 5 1993 shall complete a three-hour a three-credit-hour course in South Dakota Indian studies. The
- 6 course shall include components specific to:
- 7 (1) Language and cultural awareness;
- 8 (2) History;
- 9 (3) Educational theory and background of the traditional tribal education; and
- 10 (4) Implementation and strategies of Indian learning styles, curriculum development and
- 11 authentic assessment.
