- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions related to the required
- 2 reorganization of school districts with low enrollment.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-6-97 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 13-6-97. Any school district that has a fall enrollment, as defined in § 13-13-10.1, of less
- 6 than one hundred and is not a sparse school district, as defined in § 13-13-78, shall reorganize
- 7 with another school district or school districts to create a newly reorganized school district with
- 8 a fall enrollment of one hundred or greater. Any school district that is not sparse and has a fall
- 9 enrollment of less than one hundred or less on July 1, 2007, shall prepare a plan for
- 10 reorganization that results in a newly reorganized school district that will become operative by
- June 30 July 1, 2009. After July 1, 2007, if the fall enrollment of any school district that is not
- sparse falls to below one hundred or below, that school district shall prepare a plan for
- 13 reorganization that results in a newly reorganized school district that will become operative
- within two years. If any such district fails to prepare a plan for reorganization by the deadline,
- the South Dakota Board of Education shall prepare and implement a reorganization plan for the

- district to dissolve and attach to another school district or districts. However, the provisions of
- 2 this section do not apply to any school district that contracts with a school district in another
- 3 state pursuant to § 13-15-11 to provide for the education of children in grades seven through
- 4 twelve who reside within the district, that receives no foundation program state aid distributed
- 5 pursuant to chapter 13-13, and that is located at least twenty-five miles from the nearest high
- 6 school in an adjoining school district in the state.
