1	FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation to reimburse certain family
2	physicians, midlevel practitioners, and dentists who have complied with the requirements
3	of the physician tuition reimbursement program, the midlevel tuition reimbursement
4	program, or the dental tuition reimbursement program.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
6	Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one hundred
7	twenty-four thousand eight hundred ninety-four dollars (\$124,894), or so much thereof as may
8	be necessary, to the Department of Health for the purposes of reimbursing one family physician,
9	one physician assistant, and one dentist who have, in the determination of the department, met
10	the requirements of the state physician tuition reimbursement program established pursuant to
11	§ 1-16A-71.1, the midlevel tuition reimbursement program pursuant to § 1-16A-73.6, or the
12	dental tuition reimbursement program established pursuant to § 1-16A-73.20.
13	Section 2. The secretary of the Department of Health shall approve vouchers and the state
14	auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
15	Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
