- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require the Board of Pharmacy to report to the
- 2 Legislature regarding monitoring and use of opioids in the state.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 The board shall, before the fourth Tuesday in January of each year, report to the Senate and
- 6 House standing committees on health and human services on the monitoring and use of
- 7 prescription opioids. This report shall include the number of opioid prescriptions from the prior
- 8 three years. The report shall also include an update to any changes or advances made to the
- 9 prescription drug monitoring program.
- 10 Section 2. Section 1 of this Act is repealed on June 30, 2022.
