10	proceeding, civil or criminal, has been commenced prior to July 1, <del>2016</del> <u>2017</u> , to determine			
11	1 whether or not such provision was constitutionally enacted, is validated by the enactment of this			
12	code.			
13	3 The enactment of the code:			
14	(1)	(1) Does not affect the validity of any transaction;		
15	(2)	Does not impair the curative or legalizing effect of any statute; and		
16	(3)	Does not release or extinguish any penalty, confiscation, forfeiture, or liability; which		
17		accrued, occurred, or took effect prior to the time the code took effect.		
18	8 Section 3. That § 2-16-16 be amended to read:			
19	2-16-16. All statutes, other than this code, enacted at the $\frac{2016}{2017}$ session of the			
20	0 Legislature shall be deemed to have been enacted subsequently to the enactment of this code.			
21	If any such statute repeals, amends, contravenes, or is inconsistent with the provisions of this			
22	code, the provisions of the statute shall prevail. Any enactment in the $\frac{2016}{2017}$ session of the			
23	Legislature which that cites South Dakota Codified Laws for the purpose of amendment or			
24	repeal, shall be construed as having reference to the code enacted by § 2-16-13.
