SENATE BILL NO. 18

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Board of Regents

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the Board of Regents to contract for the design,
2 renovation of, and addition to, the Stanley J. Marshall Center on the campus of South
3 Dakota State University and to make an appropriation therefor.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. The Board of Regents is hereby authorized to contract for the design, renovation
6 of, and addition to, the Stanley J. Marshall Center on the campus of South Dakota State
7 University in Brookings, together with furnishings and equipment, including heating, air
8 conditioning, plumbing, water, sewer, electric facilities, sidewalks, parking, landscaping,
9 architectural and engineering services, asbestos abatement, and such other services or actions
10 as may be required to accomplish the project, for an estimated cost of fifteen million dollars,
11 subject to permitted adjustments pursuant to section 3 of this Act.

12 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated for the purposes authorized in this Act the sum of
13 fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, in other fund
14 expenditure authority to the Board of Regents from the athletic department rental and
15 advertising revenue, funds donated to the Board of Regents for the project authorized by this



1 Act, together with any additional sums received pursuant to section 4 of this Act, and permitted
2 adjustments pursuant to section 3 of this Act.

3 Section 3. The cost estimates contained in this Act have been stated in terms of 2016 values.
4 The Board of Regents may adjust the cost estimates to reflect inflation as measured by the
5 Building Cost Index reported by the Engineering News Record, additional expenditures required
6 to comply with regulations adopted after the effective date of this Act, or additional sums
7 received pursuant to section 4 of this Act.

8 Section 4. The Board of Regents may accept, transfer, and expend any funds obtained for
9 the projects authorized in this Act from federal sources, donations, or any other external sources,
10 all of which comprise a special fund for the benefitted project. All moneys deposited into that
11 fund are hereby appropriated to the projects authorized by this Act, subject to the limitations
12 stated in sections 1 to 3, inclusive, of this Act.

13 Section 5. The administration of the design and construction of the project authorized in this
14 Act shall be under the general charge and supervision of the Bureau of Administration as
15 provided in chapter 5-14.

16 Section 6. The executive director of the Board of Regents shall approve vouchers and the
17 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
