- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding the education
- 2 provided for children in certain residential treatment centers.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-28-11 be amended to read:
- 5 13-28-11. If a child is residing in a residential treatment center or an intensive residential
- 6 treatment center which provides care for children who are not living with their parents or
- 7 guardian, the school residence of the child is the school district where the parents or guardian
- 8 reside, subject to the provisions of § 13-28-9.
- 9 The that provides an educational program through a school district, the school district where 10 π the residential treatment center or intensive residential treatment center is located is 11 responsible for providing an educational program for the children who reside in the residential 12 treatment center or intensive residential treatment center child. Tuition for a child who is not 13 eligible for special education services at the time of placement and is enrolled in a public school 14 district is the responsibility of the school district where the child was enrolled at the time of
- 15 placement in the residential treatment center or intensive residential treatment center. The



amount of tuition paid by that school district for any child placed in a residential treatment

center or intensive residential treatment center who is not eligible for special education services

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3 at the time of placement shall be calculated as follows: 4 - Divide the current per student equivalent as defined in § 13-13-10.1 by one hundred (1)seventy-five; and 5 6 Multiply the result obtained in subdivision (1) by the number of days the child is (2)7 placed. 8 This section applies only to a residential treatment center or intensive residential treatment 9 center that provided an educational program through a school district in the 2013-2014 school 10 year or that initiates an educational program through a school district in a subsequent school 11 year. A The Department of Education shall pay tuition to a school district providing 20 education for children in a residential treatment center or intensive residential treatment center 21 shall receive an amount equal to the current year's per student equivalent as defined in § 13-13-22 10.1 multiplied by the average daily membership, in the prior school year, for residentially-23 placed students attending each residential treatment center or intensive residential treatment

24 center for whom tuition is paid by another school district pursuant to § 13-28-11. This section
