- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That chapter 13-1 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 4 No teacher may be prohibited from helping students understand, analyze, critique, or review
- 5 in an objective scientific manner the strengths and weaknesses of scientific information
- 6 presented in courses being taught which are aligned with the content standards established
- 7 pursuant to § 13-3-48.
