HOUSE BILL NO. 1036

AN ACT TO REVISE CERTAIN PROVISIONS CONCERNING VOTER REGISTRATION AND NOTICES OF BOUNDARY CHANGES FOR LOCAL ELECTIONS.

A prison/jail population cost estimate statement has been requested on HB1036 due to changing the penalty of SDCL 12-4-41 from a Class 2 misdemeanor to a Class 1 misdemeanor.

The current statute makes using information from the statewide voter registration file or county voter registration file for a commercial purpose a Class 2 misdemeanor. There has been no charges or convictions in the past six years under the current statute. For that reason it is the opinion of the Legislative Research Council that HB 1036 will have no impact.
