- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise when improvement districts shall hold an election
- 2 of board members.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 7-25A-10 be amended to read:
- 5 7-25A-10. The board shall schedule an election of board members to be held not later than
- 6 the on or before:
- 7 (1) The date of the first general municipal election following after the tenth anniversary
- 8 of the formation of the district<u>; or</u>
- 9 (2) The first general municipal election after the board receives notice of certification
- 10 from the county auditor that at least forty-five registered voters reside in the district;
- 11 which ever occurs last.
- 12 The county auditor shall count the number of registered voters in each district in the county
- 13 before December second of each odd numbered year. If the county auditor counts forty-five or
- 14 more registered voters residing in the district, the county auditor shall certify the number of



1 registered voters in that district and send notice of certification, by certified mail, to the board. 2 No county auditor is required to count the number of registered voters in a district after the 3 notice has been sent to the board or the district has held an election. At the first election, one 4 board member shall be elected for a six-year term, two members shall be elected for a four-year 5 term, and two members shall be elected for a two-year term. The candidate receiving the highest 6 number of votes shall serve a six-year term, the two candidates receiving the next highest 7 number of votes shall serve four-year terms, and the two candidates receiving the next highest 8 number of votes shall serve two-year terms. In succeeding elections, After the first election, the 9 term for each board member shall be elected for a six-year term. All elected board members 10 shall be registered voters of the district.
