1 A JOINT RESOLUTION, Proposing and submitting to the voters at the next general election
2 an amendment to Article XXI of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, relating to
3 fishing, hunting, and trapping.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF SOUTH
5 DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

6 Section 1. That at the next general election held in the state, the following amendment to
7 Article XXI of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, as set forth in section 2 of this
8 Joint Resolution, which is hereby agreed to, shall be submitted to the electors of the state for
9 approval.

10 Section 2. That Article XXI of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, be amended
11 by adding a NEW SECTION to read as follows:

12 § 10. Hunting, fishing, and trapping wildlife is a valued part of our heritage that shall forever



- 1 be preserved for the people; water, wildlife, and other natural resources held in the public trust
- 2 shall be managed by law and regulation for the public good but do not create a right to trespass
- 3 on private property except as allowed by law, regulation, easement, or contract.
