1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow chiropractic corporations operated as sole
2 proprietorships to be operated for a certain time after the death of the chiropractor.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 36-5-2 be amended to read:

5 36-5-2. Any person who advertises, practices, or attempts to practice chiropractic or who
6 uses the title chiropractor or any word or title having a tendency to induce any person to believe
7 that the person is a chiropractor without first having secured a license from the Board of
8 Chiropractic Examiners or an annual license renewal from the Board of Chiropractic Examiners
9 is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. This section does not apply to the estate or agent of a
10 deceased or substantially disabled chiropractor contracting with or employing a chiropractor to
11 manage the deceased or substantially disabled chiropractor's practice for a period, not to exceed
12 twenty-four months, following the date of death or substantial disability of the chiropractor,
13 until the entity can be sold or closed.
