## SENATE BILL NO. 116

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to improve online access to information concerning state
- 2 boards, commissions, and departments.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 1-25-1.3 be amended to read:
- 5 1-25-1.3. The state and each state board, commission, or department shall provide public
- 6 notice, with proposed agenda, that is visible, readable, and accessible to the public for at least
- 7 two continuous days, as that time period is computed pursuant to § 15-6-6(a), immediately
- 8 preceding any meeting, by posting a copy of the notice at the principal office of the public body
- 9 <u>board, commission, or department</u> holding the meeting. The proposed agenda shall include the
- date, time, and location of the meeting. The notice shall also be posted on the public body's
- 11 website upon dissemination of the notice, if such a website exists a state website, designated by
- 12 <u>the commissioner of the Bureau of Finance and Management</u>. For any special or rescheduled
- meeting, the information in the notice shall be delivered in person, by mail, by email, or by
- telephone, to members of the local news media who have requested notice. For any special or
- rescheduled meeting, each public body state board, commission, or department shall also

1 comply with the public notice provisions of this section for a regular meeting to the extent that

- 2 circumstances permit. A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
- 3 Section 2. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 4 Any state board, commission, or department that is required to provide public notice of its
- 5 meetings pursuant to § 1-25-1.3 shall make available on a state website designated by the
- 6 commissioner of the Bureau of Finance and Management:
- 7 (1) Financial statements;
- 8 (2) Audit reports;
- 9 (3) A list of the members of the board or commission;
- 10 (4) A schedule of future meetings;
- 11 (5) Public meeting materials that are available before a public meeting;
- 12 (6) Meeting minutes; and
- 13 (7) Annual reports.
