## HOUSE BILL NO. 1142

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the penalty for vehicular homicide.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 22-16-41 be amended to read:
- 4 22-16-41. Any person who, while under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or substances in a
- 5 manner and to a degree prohibited by § 32-23-1, without design to effect death, operates or
- 6 drives a vehicle of any kind in a negligent manner and thereby causes the death of another
- 7 person, including an unborn child, is guilty of vehicular homicide. Vehicular homicide is a Class
- 8 3 felony Class 2 felony. In addition to any other penalty prescribed by law, the court shall order
- 9 that the driver's driver license of any person convicted of vehicular homicide be revoked for a
- period of not less than ten years from the date sentence is imposed or ten years from the date of
- initial release from imprisonment, whichever is later. In the event If the person is returned to
- imprisonment prior to the completion of the period of driver's driver license revocation, time
- spent imprisoned does not count toward fulfilling the period of revocation.
