- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to define a no-go zone and create a procedure to manage
- 2 no-go zones.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 For purposes of this Act, a no-go zone is a contiguous geographical area consisting of public
- 6 space or privately owned public space where community organizing efforts systematically
- 7 intimidate or exclude the general public or public workers from entering or being present within
- 8 the area.
- 9 Section 2. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- If the attorney general receives a complaint of a no-go zone, the attorney general is
- authorized to investigate the existence of a no-go zone. If the attorney general determines that
- 12 a no-go zone exists within a municipality or a county, then the attorney general shall deliver to
- the United States Department of Justice a report that outlines the basis for such a determination.
- 14 The attorney general, in coordination with the United States Department of Justice and local law

1 enforcement, shall take all steps necessary to eliminate the no-go zone to enforce compliance

with state and federal law.
