- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide certain protections for public employees who
- 2 report violations of law.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- No department, bureau, board, or commission of the state or any of its political subdivisions
- 6 may dismiss, suspend from employment, demote, decrease the compensation of, or take any
- 7 other retaliatory action against an employee because the employee reports in good faith to an
- 8 appropriate authority a violation or suspected violation of a law or rule, an abuse of funds or
- 9 abuse of authority, or substantial and specific danger to public health or safety, unless the report
- 10 is specifically prohibited by law. The provisions of this section do not apply to any employee
- who knows the report is false or was made in a reckless disregard for the truth.
