1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to exempt a person with a commercial driver license from
2 the requirement to have a hazardous materials endorsement on the license under certain
3 conditions.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. That chapter 32-12A be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

6 A person with a commercial driver license that has a Class A combination vehicle
7 classification is not required to obtain a hazardous materials endorsement pursuant to this
8 chapter if the person is:

- 9 (1) Acting within the scope of the person's employment as an employee of a custom
10 harvester operation; and
- 11 (2) Operating a service vehicle that is transporting diesel fuel in quantity of one thousand
12 gallons or less and that is clearly marked with a flammable or combustible placard.
