1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit the unauthorized use of electronic listening or
2 recording devices in classrooms.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 13-32 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

5 No person, including a student, may use any electronic listening or recording device in any
6 classroom of a school district without the prior consent of the teacher in the classroom and the
7 principal of the school.

8 Any person, other than a student, who violates this section is guilty of a Class 2
9 misdemeanor. Any student who violates this section is subject to appropriate disciplinary action
10 as provided in school district policy.
