- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal the authority for the Department of Social
- 2 Services to enter agreements related to the Refugee Act of 1980 and to require certain
- 3 reports regarding services provided to and arrival of refugees.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 Section 1. That § 28-1-47 be repealed.
- 6 28-1-47. The Department of Social Services may enter into agreements with agencies of the
- 7 United States for the purpose of participating in the Refugee Act of 1980 (P.L. 96-212).
- 8 Section 2. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 9 Any private agency that provides services to a refugee arriving directly in South Dakota shall
- submit an annual report to the Governor and the Legislature by December thirty-first of each
- 11 year. The report shall include:
- 12 (1) A description of the services provided;
- 13 (2) A list of the municipalities or areas receiving a direct arrival refugee;
- 14 (3) The total number of direct arrival refugees;



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- 1 (4) The demographic breakout of the direct arrival refugees by age, country of origin, and
- 2 sex; and
- 3 (5) Any proposed change to the expected number of direct arrival refugees or
- 4 municipalities or areas designated to receive direct arrival refugees.
- 5 Section 3. Section 2 of this Act is repealed on December 31, 2020.
