- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide a felony penalty for the intentional injury or
- 2 disfigurement by certain corrosive materials.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 22-18 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 A person who willfully and maliciously places or throws, or causes to be placed or thrown,
- 6 upon any other person, any sulfuric acid, corrosive acid, flammable substance of any kind, or
- 7 caustic chemical of any kind, with the intent to injure or disfigure the other person, is guilty of
- 8 a Class 4 felony. The punishment imposed on a person convicted under this section shall be in
- 9 addition to any punishment imposed on the person convicted under any other section.
