## PRISON/JAIL POPULATION COST ESTIMATE STATEMENT

## HOUSE BILL NO. 1110

## AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PENALTY FOR CERTAIN SUBSEQUENT CONVICTIONS OF HIRING FOR SEXUAL ACTIVITY OR PROMOTING PROSTITUTION.

A prison/jail population cost estimate statement is required for HB1110 because the bill creates an enhanced penalty, a Class 6 felony, for those convicted of hiring for sexual activity when there is a previous conviction for that crime or promoting prostitution.

Under SDCL 22-23-9, hiring for sexual activity is a Class 1 misdemeanor. In the previous ten years, there have been 122 conviction, which receive an average 45 day jail sentence. Approximately 4.32% of convictions have multiple convictions, meaning 5 of the 122 convictions would have received the enhanced penalty under HB 1110. South Dakota could expect an enhanced penalty under HB1110 once every 2 years.

The average Class 6 felony serves an average sentence of either 74 days in jail or 185.7 days in prison. Without the enhancement, a person convicted would already serve 45 days in jail. A subsequent conviction would serve an additional 29 days in jail, at a cost of \$89.73 per day. Alternatively, a person sentenced to prison serves an average prison sentence of 185.7 days at a cost of \$42.23 per day.

Approximately 54% of Class 6 felonies receive a prison sentence compared to a jail sentence. Based on the above facts the additional costs would be as follows:
