- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding on-sale alcoholic
- 2 beverage licenses for municipal auditoriums and convention halls.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 35-4-14.1 be amended to read:
- 5 35-4-14.1. Notwithstanding the provisions of § 35-4-11, any municipality with a population
- 6 in excess of thirty-five thousand may issue an on-sale license pursuant to subdivision 35-4-2(4)
- 7 to a municipal auditorium operated pursuant to chapter 9-52 or to a public convention hall
- 8 operated pursuant to chapter 9-53 for use during a convention activity or an entertainment event,
- 9 including any theatrical or musical performance, rodeo, sporting event, or show. The selling,
- 10 serving, or dispensing of any alcoholic beverage at the municipal auditorium may not occur
- more than one hour before the commencement of the event or at any time after the event is
- 12 concluded. A license issued pursuant to this section may not be transferred.
