4 Section 1. That § 13-15A-1 be repealed.

7 ~~amended to January 1, 2010, the department shall initiate a pilot charter school primarily for~~
8 ~~American Indian students from federally recognized tribes that is infused with cultural activities.~~
9 ~~The curriculum of the school shall emphasize science, technology, engineering, and~~
10 ~~mathematics as well as American Indian culture.~~

11 Section 2. That §§ 13-15A-2 to 13-15A-10, inclusive, be repealed.
