1 A JOINT RESOLUTION, Proposing and submitting to the voters at the next general election 2 an amendment to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, relating to fishing, hunting, 3 and trapping. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF SOUTH 4 5 DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 6 Section 1. That at the next general election held in the state, the following amendment to Article XXI of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, as set forth in section 2 of this 8 Joint Resolution, which is hereby agreed to, shall be submitted to the electors of the state for 9 approval. 10 Section 2. That Article XXI of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, be amended 11 by adding a NEW SECTION to read as follows: 12 § 10. The right to hunt, fish, trap, and harvest wildlife is a valued part of South Dakota's 13 heritage and shall be forever preserved for the public good. 14 The people have a right, including using traditional methods, to hunt, fish, trap, and harvest 15 wildlife subject only to the laws prescribed by the Legislature and rules prescribed by virtue of - 2 - HJR 1005

- 1 the authority of the Legislature to:
- 2 (1) Promote wildlife conservation and management; and
- 3 (2) Preserve the future of hunting, fishing, and trapping.
- 4 Hunting, fishing, and trapping shall be a preferred means of managing and controlling
- 5 wildlife.
- This section does not limit the application of any provision of law relating to trespass or
- 7 property rights.
