- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require certain reports in the event of an oil spill.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That chapter 34A-18 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 4 In the event of any oil spill, the department shall immediately conduct a chemical analysis
- 5 on the contents of the spill, the ground surrounding the spill, and the water source closest to the
- 6 spill location. Within thirty days of the oil spill the department shall issue a report detailing the
- 7 chemical analysis of the spill. The report shall contain an elemental analysis and a
- 8 contamination analysis. The department shall make the report available to the public on the
- 9 department's website.
