- 1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Recognizing the root cause of the global war on terror.
- WHEREAS, on September 11, 2001, America woke up to the reality of the global war on
- 3 terror on our shores; and
- 4 WHEREAS, America has spent over \$6.5 trillion on the endless war on terror; and
- 5 WHEREAS, over ten thousand Americans have lost their lives and over one million
- 6 Americans have been injured in the global war on terror; and
- WHEREAS, tens of millions of Americans have been affected from the pain, suffering, and
- 8 sacrifice of their loved ones; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Americans deserve to know our military and their families' sacrifice of blood
- and treasure is for a noble purpose and their mission is clearly defined; and
- WHEREAS, the enemy terrorist organizations are fighting in the name of Islam, and they
- believe in the full implementation of Islamic law, known as Sharia law; and
- WHEREAS, the global war on terror is fought in primarily Muslim majority countries

- 2 WHEREAS, these Islamic terrorist organizations are known as the Islamic State of Iraq and
- 3 Syria, (ISIS), Al Qaeda, Boko Haram, al-Shabaab, Hamas, Hezbollah, the Taliban, the Muslim
- 4 Brotherhood, and by other names, and they have stated intentions of infiltrating the entire world
- 5 with their ideology; and
- 6 WHEREAS, many Muslim majority countries believe in the full implementation of Islamic
- 7 law that subscribes to the belief that one should be killed for leaving Islam;
- 8 WHEREAS, South Dakota values individual freedom, human rights, and freedom of speech
- 9 and welcomes people of all races, colors, religions, creeds, sexes, and national origins to
- 10 assimilate into American culture and society with all of the immigrants who have come before:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Senate of the Ninety-Third Legislature
- of the State of South Dakota, the House of Representatives concurring therein, that South
- 13 Dakota petitions the Department of Homeland Security and the Federal Department of Justice
