## SENATE BILL NO. 24

Introduced by: The Committee on Education at the request of the Department of Education

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions relating to state assessments.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 13-3-55 be amended to read:
- 4 13-3-55. Every public school district shall annually administer the same assessment
- 5 assessments in English language arts, mathematics, and science. The assessments in English
- 6 <u>language arts and mathematics shall be administered</u> to all students in grades three to eight,
- 7 inclusive, and in grade eleven once in high school. The assessments in science shall be
- 8 administered to students once in grades three to five, once in grades six to eight, and once in
- 9 high school. The assessment assessments shall measure the academic progress of each student.
- 10 Every public school district shall annually administer to all students in at least two grade levels
- an achievement test to assess writing skills. The assessment instruments assessments shall be
- provided by the Department of Education, and the department shall determine the two grade
- 13 levels to be tested. The tests shall be and administered within timelines established by the
- 14 Department of Education by rules promulgated pursuant to chapter 1-26 starting in the spring
- of the 2002-2003 school year department. Each state-designed test assessment shall be

- 1 correlated with the state's content standards. The same assessments shall be administered to all
- 2 <u>students, except students with the most severe cognitive disabilities.</u> The South Dakota Board
- 3 of Education Standards may promulgate rules, pursuant to chapter 1-26, to provide for the
- 4 administration of all assessments.
