1	FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise qualifications for sanitary district trustees.
2	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
3	Section 1. That § 34A-5-14.1 be amended to read:
4	34A-5-14.1. Each sanitary district shall be governed by a board of trustees elected at large,
5	as provided in this chapter. To be eligible for office, each trustee shall reside in the district. The
6	Each board of trustees shall consist of an odd number of members and shall have at least three
7	but not more than eleven members, as provided in this section.
8	A If a sanitary district that provides or is proposed to provide sewer or water facility
9	connections to more than one thousand five hundred households, farms, businesses, or other
10	entities shall have a, the board of trustees shall consist of at least five but not more than eleven
11	members. A If a sanitary district that provides or is proposed to provide at least one thousand
12	but no not more than one thousand five hundred such sewer or water facility connections shall
13	have a, the board of trustees shall consist of at least five but not more than nine members. A If
14	<u>a</u> sanitary district that provides or is proposed to provide at least five hundred but not more than
15	one thousand such sewer or water facility connections shall have a, the board of trustees shall



1	<u>consist</u> of at least three but not more than seven members. A <u>If a</u> sanitary district that provides
2	or is proposed to provide less fewer than five hundred such sewer or water facility connections
3	shall have a, the board of trustees shall consist of at least three but not more than five members.
4	The number of trustees for a newly incorporated or consolidated sanitary district shall be
5	specified in the order of incorporation issued under § 34A-5-7 or in the consolidation resolution
6	issued under § 34A-5-46.
7	Section 2. That § 34A-5-21.2 be amended to read:
8	34A-5-21.2. A To serve as a trustee of a sanitary district trustee that provides or is proposed
9	to provide sewer or water facility connections to more than one hundred households, farms,
10	businesses, or other entities, a person shall be a resident of the sanitary district the trustee
11	represents.
12	To serve as a trustee of a sanitary district that provides or is proposed to provide sewer or
13	water facility connections to no more than one hundred households, farms, businesses, or other
14	entities, a person shall be a resident of the sanitary district or own real property within the
15	boundary of the sanitary district.
