## Senate Bill no. 103

Introduced by: Senators Novstrup, Maher, Schoenbeck, Stalzer, and Wismer and Representatives Perry, Brunner, Chase, McCleerey, and Smith (Jamie)

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for an annual transfer of certain unobligated state
- 2 general funds into the local bridge improvement grant fund.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 4-7-32 be amended to read:
- 5 4-7-32. On July first of each fiscal year or at such time that the prior fiscal year general fund
- 6 ending unobligated cash balance is determined, the commissioner of the Bureau of Finance and
- 7 Management shall transfer all prior year unobligated cash up to an amount equal to ten percent
- 8 of the general fund appropriations from the general appropriation act for the prior fiscal year <u>as</u>
- 9 <u>follows:</u>
- 10 (1) <u>Seventy-five percent of the unobligated cash</u> into the budget reserve fund; and
- 11 (2) Twenty-five percent of the unobligated cash into the local bridge improvement grant
  12 fund created by § 32-11-38.

- 13 In no event shall the cash balance in the budget reserve fund be greater than ten percent of
- 14 the general fund appropriations from the general appropriation act for the prior fiscal year.
- 15 Expenditures out of the budget reserve fund shall only be by special appropriation of the

- 1 Legislature and shall only redress such unforeseen expenditure obligations or such unforeseen
- 2 revenue shortfalls as may constitute an emergency pursuant to S.D. Const., Art. III, § 1.
