1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise provisions regarding state-owned motor vehicles.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That chapter 5-25 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

4 Each office, department, institution, board, and agency of this state shall maintain and
5 operate any state-owned passenger motor vehicle for at least ten years or until the vehicle
6 reaches a mileage of at least one hundred and seventy-five thousand miles, before the vehicle
7 may be removed from operation. However, if the vehicle is damaged and the cost to repair
8 would be greater than the value of the vehicle, the motor vehicle may be removed from service.
