- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit intentionally damaging monuments, statues, or
- 2 memorials and provide a penalty therefor.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 22-34 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 Any person who, with specific intent, damages, destroys, or defaces any monument, statue,
- 6 or memorial designated as a historical or cultural landmark is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor
- 7 if the damage to property is five thousand dollars or less.
- 8 Any person who, with specific intent, damages, destroys, or defaces any monument, statue,
- 9 or memorial designated as a historical or cultural landmark is guilty of a Class 6 felony if the
- damage to property is more than five thousand dollars.
