- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish the duty to collect data and share information
- 2 on missing and murdered indigenous persons.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 23-3 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 The Division of Criminal Investigation shall collect data and share information on missing
- 6 and murdered indigenous persons in cooperation with similar divisions, bureaus, or departments
- 7 of other states, tribal governments or law enforcement agencies, county or municipal
- 8 governments and law enforcement agencies, the Bureau of Indian Affairs of the U.S.
- 9 Department of the Interior, or the Bureau of Investigation of the U.S. Department of Justice.
