- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding certification of utility
- 2 permits.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 49-41B-27 be amended to read:
- 5 49-41B-27. Utilities which that have acquired a permit in accordance with the provisions
- 6 of this chapter may proceed to improve, expand, or construct the facility for the intended
- 7 purposes at any time, subject to the provisions of this chapter; provided, however, that if such
- 8 construction, expansion and improvement commences more than four years after a permit has
- 9 been issued, then the utility must certify to the Public Utilities Commission that such the facility
- 10 continues to meet the conditions upon which the permit was issued under the original issuance
- 11 of the permit.
- 12 Upon receipt of a request for certification under this section, the commission shall follow
- 13 the procedures for a contested case set forth in chapter 1-26. For certification to be granted, the
- 14 applicant shall present substantial evidence of its history of compliance with all prior

- 1 commission permit conditions. The commission shall consider the prior performance of the
- 2 applicant on similar projects, including past violations of applicable state, federal, and tribal
- 3 laws or regulations. A certification by the commission under this section shall be subject to
- 4 judicial review in the circuit court under the provisions of chapter 1-26.
