- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 22-19B-1 be amended to read:
- 4 22-19B-1. No A person may is guilty of a Class 6 felony if the person maliciously and with
- 5 the specific intent to intimidate or harass any other person or specific group of persons because
- of that person's or group of persons' race, ethnicity, religion, ancestry, or national origin, sexual
- 7 orientation, or gender identity:
- 8 (1) Cause Causes physical injury to another person; or
- 9 (2) Deface Defaces any real or personal property of another person; or
- 10 (3) Damage or destroy <u>Damages or destroys</u> any real or personal property of another
- 11 person; or
- 12 (4) Threaten Threatens, by word or act, to do the acts prohibited under this section if
- there is reasonable cause to believe that any of the acts prohibited in subdivision (1),

- 1 (2), or (3) of this section will occur.
- 2 A violation of this section is a Class 6 felony.
