## HOUSE BILL NO. 1084

Introduced by: The Committee on Judiciary at the request of the Chief Justice

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to permit the appointment of a special advocate to represent
- 2 the best interests of an apparent or alleged abused or neglected child.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 26-8A-20 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 26-8A-20. If a child is an apparent or alleged abused or neglected child, the court may
- 6 appoint a special advocate to represent the best interests of the child and to assist the child's
- 7 attorney. If a child has been adjudicated an abused or neglected child and is removed from the
- 8 child's home with the child's parents, guardian or custodian, the court shall appoint a guardian
- 9 ad litem or a special advocate to represent the best interests of the child and to assist the child's
- attorney. The guardian ad litem or special advocate is an officer of the court for the purpose of
- representing the child's best interests. The guardian ad litem or special advocate shall receive
- all reports concerning the child and may cause the case to be reviewed by the court pursuant to
- 13 § 26-8A-23.
