## JOINT APPROPRIATIONS ENGROSSED NO. SB 176 - 2/27/2019

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Office of the Governor

- FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation for the second century habitat fund and to declare an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of five hundred
- 5 thousand dollars (\$500,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Bureau of Finance
- and Management to provide a grant to the second century habitat fund held with the South
- 7 Dakota Community Foundation and administered by the executive board of the second century
- 8 habitat fund for the protection and enhancement of wildlife habitat across the state.
- 9 Section 2. The funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act may be used to match one dollar
- 10 received from private contributions or private donations, or may be used as matching funds for
- 11 federal conservation programs or grants for which the second century habitat fund successfully
- 12 applies or for any larger, collaborative effort of which the second century habitat fund is a
- partner and is administered by the executive board of the second century habitat fund.
- Section 3. The funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act shall be used for program

- 1 operations and may not be added to an endowment.
- 2 Section 4. The commissioner of the Bureau of Finance and Management shall approve
- 3 vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
- 4 Section 5. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 5 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
- 6 Section 6. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 7 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
- 8 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
