

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to schedule certain controlled substances and to declare an
- 2 emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 34-20B-14 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 34-20B-14. Any material, compound, mixture, or preparation which contains any quantity
- of the following hallucinogenic substances, their salts, isomers, and salts of isomers, is included
- 7 in Schedule I, unless specifically excepted, whenever the existence of such salts, isomers, and
- 8 salts of isomers is possible within the specific chemical designation:
- 9 (1) Bufotenine;
- 10 (2) Diethyltryptamine;
- 11 (3) Dimethyltryptamine;
- 12 (4) 5-methoxy-N, N-Dimethyltryptamine;
- 13 (5) 5-methoxy-3, 4-methylenedioxy amphetamine;
- 14 (6) 4-bromo-2, 5-dimethoxyamphetamine;

- Section 2. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
- 21 health, or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force and
- 22 effect from and after its passage and approval.
