- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal the limited campaign finance disclosure statement
- 2 which could be used by certain candidates or candidate campaign committees for legislative
- 3 office.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 Section 1. That § 12-27-44 be repealed.
- 6 12-27-44. Any candidate or candidate campaign committee for legislative office that has
- 7 spent less than ten thousand dollars and has received less than ten thousand dollars in
- 8 contributions and loans by the fifteenth day before any primary or general election is only
- 9 required to file a campaign finance disclosure statement containing the information required in
- 10 subdivisions 12-27-24(1), (2), (8), (10), and (29) before any election.
