## HOUSE BILL NO. 1182

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to increase the required minimum school district size from
- a fall enrollment of one hundred to a fall enrollment of one hundred ninety-five.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-6-97 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 13-6-97. Any school district that has a fall enrollment, as defined in § 13-13-10.1, of less
- 6 than one hundred <u>ninety-five</u> and is not a sparse school district, as defined in § 13-13-78, shall
- 7 reorganize with another school district or school districts to create a newly reorganized school
- 8 district with a fall enrollment of one hundred <u>ninety-five</u> or greater. Any school district that is
- 9 not sparse and has a fall enrollment of one hundred or less on July 1, 2007, shall prepare a plan
- 10 for reorganization by June 30, 2009. After July 1, 2007, if If the fall enrollment of any school
- district that is not sparse falls to one hundred <u>ninety-five</u> or below, that school district shall
- prepare a plan for reorganization within two years. If any such district fails to prepare a plan for
- reorganization by the deadline, the Board of Education shall prepare a reorganization plan for
- the district. However, the provisions of this section do not apply to any school district that
- 15 contracts with a school district in another state pursuant to § 13-15-11 to provide for the

- 1 education of children in grades seven through twelve who reside within the district, that receives
- 2 no foundation program state aid distributed pursuant to chapter 13-13, and that is located at least
- 3 twenty-five miles from the nearest high school in an adjoining school district in the state.
