House Bill 1031

Introduced by: The Committee on Education at the request of the Department of Education

- 1 An Act to revise certain provisions regarding school district fiduciary funds.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- **Section 1.** That § 13-16-19 be AMENDED:

13-16-19. Custodial funds--Stewardship--Designation of employee--Surety bond.

The school board shall prescribe policies and procedures governing the stewardship of agency custodial funds consistent with provisions of this title. The school board may designate an employee of the school district to be in charge of each agency custodial fund. The employee designated, if other than the business manager, shall be placed under surety bond in the amount which it is estimated will to be in the hands of such the employee at any one time during the school fiscal year. The school district shall pay the premium on such the surety bond.

Section 2. That § 13-16-20 be AMENDED:

13-16-20. Disbursements--Records--Receipts--Payment of claims--Serially numbered ticket sales--Destruction of records.

The employee in charge of <u>an agency a custodial</u> fund may issue checks for disbursements from the fund. Unless required by the school board, <u>such the</u> disbursements do not require prior approval by the board nor signature of the presiding officer of the board or the business manager. The employee designated shall keep accurate records of all receipts, expenditures, and balances of the <u>agency custodial</u> fund; issue receipts in duplicate for all money received, except money received from the sale of printed serial number admission tickets; approve the expenditures, and pay all claims upon the presentation of an itemized verified claim. A memorandum record shall be kept on file for the sale of all serially numbered tickets by events, <u>which and the record shall</u> be signed by the person selling <u>such the tickets</u>. <u>However, the The employee may destroy</u>

any record that the records destruction board, acting pursuant to § 1-27-19, declares to have no further administrative, legal, fiscal, research, or historical value.

The employee of the school district designated by the board to be in charge of an agency a custodial fund shall monthly and annually submit reports to the school board. The fund shall be audited as part of the regular audit of the school district.
