- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for certain restrictions for the use of tanning
- devices by minors.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 26-10 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 No person may permit a minor to use a tanning device at a tanning facility without the
- 7 consent of a parent or legal guardian. A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
- 8 Section 2. That chapter 26-10 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 9 follows:
- The consent required pursuant to section 1 of this Act shall be evidenced by either of the
- 11 following written documents:
- 12 (1) A notarized statement of consent signed and dated by a parent or legal guardian; or
- 13 (2) A statement of consent signed and dated by a parent or legal guardian in the presence
- of any person responsible for the operation of the tanning device at the tanning

- 2 Any consent meeting the requirements of this section expires one year after the date of the
- 3 consent.
- 4 Section 3. That chapter 26-10 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 Terms used in this Act mean:
- 7 (1) "Tanning device," equipment that emits electromagnetic radiation having
 8 wavelengths in the air between two hundred and four hundred nanometers and that
 9 is used for tanning human skin. The term does not include a phototherapy device
 10 used by a physician licensed pursuant to chapter 36-4 that emits ultraviolet radiation
 11 and is used in treating disease;
- 12 (2) "Tanning facility," a place or business that provides persons access to a tanning device.
