

2020 South Dakota Legislature Senate Bill 52

Introduced by: Senator Ernie Otten 1 An Act to create a state seal specialty plate emblem. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 2 3 Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added: 32-5-168.1. State seal--Emblem set. 4 5 The state seal may be used as an emblem for emblem specialty plates under § 32-6 5-169. A fifty dollar fee shall be assessed for each emblem set purchased under this 7 section. Each office of a county treasurer shall be stocked with the state seal emblem. 8 **Section 2.** That a NEW SECTION be added: 9 32-5-168.2. State seal emblem fee--Motor vehicle fund. 10 The county treasurer shall remit to the department the state seal emblem fees 11 collected under § 32-5-168.1. The fees shall be deposited in the motor vehicle fund. 12 **Section 3.** That a NEW SECTION be added: 13 32-5-168.3. State seal emblem design. 14 The state seal emblem shall be designed by the department and approved by the 15 secretary in accordance with § 1-6-2.1. The provisions of §§ 32-5-175 to 32-5-178, 16 inclusive, do not apply to the state seal emblem. 17 **Section 4.** That § 1-6-3.1 be AMENDED: 18 1-6-3.1. Use of state seal--Authorization--Violation as misdemeanor. 19 No-A person may not reproduce, duplicate, or otherwise use the official seal of the 20 State of South Dakota, or its facsimile, adopted and described in §§ 1-6-1 and 1-6-2 for 21 any for-profit, commercial purpose without specific authorization from the secretary of 22 state. However, the facsimile of the state seal may be used as an emblem for emblem <u>specialty license plates under chapter 32-5.</u> A violation of this section is a Class 1
misdemeanor.

3 Section 5. That § 1-6-3.2 be AMENDED:

1-6-3.2. Sale of replica or facsimile--Authorization--Violation as

5 **misdemeanor.**

No-<u>A</u> person may <u>not</u> sell or offer for sale a replica or facsimile of the official seal
of the State of South Dakota, adopted and described in §§ 1-6-1 and 1-6-2, without the
specific authorization from the secretary of state. <u>However, a facsimile of the state seal</u>
<u>may be sold as an emblem for emblem specialty license plates under chapter 32-5.</u> A
violation of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor.

11 **Section 6.** That § 1-6-3.3 be AMENDED:

12 **1-6-3.3.** Use of state seal--Royalty--Exceptions.

13 The secretary of state shall charge a royalty for the privilege of using the state 14 seal. The secretary of state may not charge a royalty if the state seal is used for an 15 educational purpose<u>or as an emblem under chapter 32-5</u>. All royalty fees collected 16 pursuant to this chapter shall be deposited in the state general fund.
