- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for the participation of independent voters in
- 2 primary elections.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 12-6-26 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 12-6-26. No person may vote a party ballot at any primary election unless the person is
- 6 registered as a member of that political party in the precinct in which the person seeks to vote.
- 7 Any political party in its constitution or bylaws as filed pursuant to § 12-5-1.1 may allow for
- 8 participation in the party's primary elections by any person who is registered to vote with no
- 9 party affiliation. If a person is registered as a member of a political party in the precinct in which
- 10 the person seeks to vote, the person may vote that party's ballot at any primary election. If a
- person is registered to vote with no party affiliation in the precinct in which that person seeks
- to vote, the person may vote a single party ballot of that person's choice at any primary election.
