

2020 South Dakota Legislature House Bill 1104

1An Act to limit the scope of medical information that may be required as a condition2of participation in sanctioned activities.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

| 5 | 13-36-15. Student medical informationReleaseLimitations. |
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| 6 | Except as otherwise provided in this section, the board of a school district may not |
| 7 | require that, as a condition of a student's participation in any activity sanctioned by an |
| 8 | association meeting the requirements of § 13-36-4, the student's parent provide the |
| 9 | district with a signed document authorizing a health care provider to release or disclose |
| 10 | the student's medical information. |
| 11 | The board of a school district may require that, as a condition of a student's |
| 12 | participation in any activity sanctioned by an association meeting the requirements of |
| 13 | § 13-36-4, the student's parent provide to the district a copy of the student's physical |
| 14 | examination form, signed by a doctor of medicine, a doctor of osteopathy, a doctor of |
| 15 | chiropractic, a nurse practitioner, or a physician assistant, and if a physical examination |
| 16 | is not required on an annual basis, the student's annual interim pre-participation medical |
| 17 | history form, signed by the student's parent and certifying that the student is physically |
| 18 | able to participate in an activity. |
| 19 | Information provided under this section is deemed to be part of the student's |
| 20 | educational record and may be utilized by school district personnel only to: |
| 21 | (1) Verify the student's physical ability to participate in a sanctioned activity; |
| 22 | (2) Identify any limitations on the student's physical ability to participate in a |
| 23 | sanctioned activity; and |
| 24 | (3) Participate in any of the student's treatment protocols, provided the protocols are |
| 25 | determined by a health care provider working under the provider's scope of |
| 26 | practice and the participation is at the direction of the provider. |
