2020 South Dakota Legislature Senate Bill 91

Introduced by: Senator Russell

1 An Act to revise provisions regarding the salary for state's attorneys. 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 3 Section 1. That § 7-7-12 be AMENDED:

7-7-12. Salary for state's attorney--Contract for services when no attorney elected--Salary not to be decreased during term of office.

The board of county commissioners shall establish, by resolution, the salary payable to the state's attorney. The salary payable may not be less than the following schedule as based upon the most recent decennial federal census of population for counties:

10	County Population	Salary Schedule
11	Below 5,000	\$34,554
12	5,000 - 9,999	\$37,673
13	10,000 - 20,000	\$44,492
14	20,000 - 49,999	\$47,728

In counties of over fifty thousand population where a full-time state's attorney is 15 required or in counties where the commissioners designate the position full-time the sum 16 17 of seventy-one thousand five hundred thirty-four dollars per year. In counties of less than fifty thousand population the commissioners may designate the position full-time. The 18 decision by the commissioners shall be adopted prior to the first day of January in the 19 year of the election and may not only be amended for that term of office with the consent 20 of both the state's attorney and the commissioners. However, if If no state's attorney is 21 elected to the office at any general election, the board of county commissioners may 22 contract for such legal services and negotiate the compensation therefor on terms and 23 24 conditions determined by the board of county commissioners. The board of county

1commissioners may not decrease the salary of the state's attorney during consecutive2terms of office of the state's attorney.
