1A LEGISLATIVE COMMEMORATION, honoring and commending Brookings Area2Habitat for Humanity for twenty-five years of working toward their vision of3creating a world where everyone has a decent place to live by building and4preserving decent and affordable housing.

5 <u>WHEREAS, the lack of affordable housing for the lowest income households is a serious</u> 6 problem across the state; and

WHEREAS, Brookings Habitat was founded in February of 1995 and is part of Habitat for
 Humanity-International's global mission advocating for increased access to decent and
 affordable housing; and

10 WHEREAS, Brookings Habitat, through partnerships with homeowners, volunteers, and 11 sponsors, not only builds houses, but builds homes, relationships, and neighborhoods where 12 families in our communities are offered a better life; where children are safe; where property 13 values increase and crime is reduced; and where dreams of homeownership become a reality; 14 and

WHEREAS, Brookings Habitat has worked alongside one hundred forty families in
 Brookings and Lake Counties building greater strength, stability, and self-reliance through
 shelter; and

18 <u>WHEREAS</u>, Brookings Habitat continues this work year after year, engaging hundreds of

volunteers working alongside homebuyers who provide sweat equity, a down payment, and
 who pay an affordable mortgage; and

- 21 <u>WHEREAS, Brookings Habitat families are good neighbors and active members of their</u> 22 <u>community; and</u>
- 23 WHEREAS, Brookings Area Habitat for Humanity ReStore collects donations of household
- 24 goods, furniture, and construction materials making them available at low cost to members

of the community while at the same time diverting over one hundred tons of material annually
 from our landfill; and
 WHEREAS, Brookings Area Habitat for Humanity continues working on the elimination of
 substandard housing through philanthropy, volunteering, praying, and advocating for better
 housing solutions:
