

2020 South Dakota Legislature House Bill 1130

1 An Act to revise the requirements for an enhanced permit to carry a concealed pistol.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 23-7-53 be AMENDED:

4	23-7-53. Enhanced permit to carry concealed pistolInitial application		
5	Renewal.		
6	An applicant may submit an application to the sheriff of the county in which the		
7	applicant resides for an optional <u>A person may apply for an</u> enhanced permit to carry a		
8	concealed pistol. The application shall include or for a renewal of an enhanced permit, by		
9	submitting to the sheriff of the county in which the person resides:		
10	(1)	The <u>A completed</u> application for the optional enhanced permit to carry a concealed	
11		pistol ;	
12	(2)	A copy of the applicant's person's fingerprints for submission to the Federal Bureau	
13		of Investigation, and to any governmental agency or entity that is authorized to	
14		receive such information,f or in order to conduct a state, national, and international	
15		criminal history background check;	
16	(3)	An authorization <u>to run for</u> a fingerprint background check;	
17	(4)	A-separate payment fee of forty-three dollars and twenty-five cents for the cost of	
18		processing the fingerprint background check and, if the sheriff takes the	
19		fingerprints, the sheriff shall secure the fingerprints at no additional charge to the	
20		applicant;	
21	(5)	A separate application	
22		<u>(a) A</u> fee of one hundred dollars for the optional <u>an initial</u> permit to carry a	
23		concealed pistol which shall be distributed, fifty percent to <u>of which</u> must	
24		<u>be retained by the sheriff and fifty percent of which must be provided to the</u>	
25		secretary of state to be used by the secretary of state to administer<u>for</u>	
26		administration of the concealed carry program; and or	

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1	<u>(b)</u>	A fee of fifty dollars for the renewal of a permit to carry a concealed pistol,
2		fifty percent of which must be retained by the sheriff and fifty percent of
3		which must be provided to the secretary of state for administration of the
4		concealed carry program; and
5	(6) Proof	f that the applicant has successfully person:
6	<u>(a)</u>	Successfully completed a qualifying handgun course, as defined in § 23-7-
7		58 within the preceding twelve months <u>;</u> or proof that the applicant is
8	<u>(b)</u>	<u>Is a current or former South Dakota law enforcement officer.</u>
9	<u>An a</u>	pplication for the renewal of an enhanced permit may not be submitted earlier
10	<u>than ninety</u>	days prior to the expiration date printed on the permit.
11	The s	sheriff shall forward the to the Division of Criminal Investigation for processing
12	<u>a</u> copy of t	he applicant's fingerprints, the applicant's authorization for processing to
13	<u>process</u> a	fingerprint background check, and the payment <u>fee</u> for the fingerprint
14	background	check to the Division of Criminal Investigation for processing. A sheriff may
15	<u>not charge a</u>	a fee for collecting fingerprints required by this section.
16	Section 2 Tha	t § 23-7-54 be AMENDED:
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23-7-54. Temporary enhanced permit to carry concealed pistol--Issuance.

The sheriff shall retain the application and other documents until the sheriff receives the results of the background checks required pursuant to § 23-7-53. Within seven days following receipt of a confirmation that the applicant passed each criminal background check required pursuant to this section and § 23-7-53, the sheriff shall file the application with the secretary of state pursuant to § 23-7-8.

23 If the applicant a person submits an application for an initial or a renewed permit 24 pursuant to § 23-7-53, meets the requirements of § 23-7-7.1, is not otherwise prohibited 25 by state or federal law, 18 U.S.C. 922(g) as amended to October 26, 2005, or 18 U.S.C. 26 922(n) as amended to October 26, 2005, from receiving, possessing, or transporting a 27 firearm, passes the required fingerprint background check, and passes a National Instant 28 Criminal Background Check, the sheriff of the county where the applicant to whom the 29 person submitted the application shall, within thirty days of receiving the application, issue 30 the applicant to the person a temporary enhanced permit to carry a concealed pistol. The 31 temporary permit must that clearly designate that designates the permit is as being 32 enhanced.

33 Section 3. That § 23-7-56 be REPEALED.
